Three bodies (Sun, Mercury and Venus) occupy Libra, the scales for balance. Final days of Jupiter retrograde in Aries and Saturn retrograde in Aquarius. Both planets will go in direct motion on 10/23/2022, leaving only Neptune and Pluto in retrograde for this season.

*Exo 12:1-3,6 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, **This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.** Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house: And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.

Deu 16:1 **Observe the month of Abib**, and keep the passover unto the LORD thy God: for **in the month of Abib the LORD thy God brought thee forth out of Egypt by night.** ****The Last Great Day of the Feast - Lev 23:39** Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the Yahuah seven days: on the first day shall be a sabbath, and on the eighth day [last day] shall be a sabbath. - **John 7:37** In the last day, that great day of the feast, Yahushua stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

Please note that biblical days begin at the evening, at sunset; check the 6 instances of the phrase "the evening and the morning" in Genesis 1. For instance, the Day of Atonement, the 10th day of the 7th Moon/Month, 10/5/2022, began Tuesday evening, 10/04/2022, the 9th day of Ethanim, at sunset, 5:55 P.M. EDT.
