*Exo 12:1-3,6 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, **This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.** Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house: And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.
Deu 16:1 **Observe the month of Abib,** and keep the passover unto the LORD thy God: for **in the month of Abib the LORD thy God brought thee forth out of Egypt by night.**

BUL - The 8th moon/month 1 Kings 6:38 And in the eleventh year, in the month of Bul, which is the eighth month, the house was finished in all its details and according to all its plans. So he was seven years in building it.

Please note that biblical days begin at the evening, at sunset; check the 6 instances of the phrase "the evening and the morning" in Genesis 1.
